

Parrot Head Profile of Jerry Emery



Jerry and his wife, Connie bought their Villages home in July 2009, and made it their full time residence 3 years later. They joined The Parrot Heads shortly after becoming Villagers in October 2009. They reside in the Village of Poinciana.

1. Jerry, how did you first become acquainted with the Parrot Heads?

I was at The Sumter Lake Town Square and saw someone wearing a Parrot Head shirt from The Quad Cities (IL and IOWA). It was Will. We chatted about the Villages Parrot Heads and that Connie and I have always been Jimmy Buffet fans, attending many of his concerts. So that led us to join the club and get involved.

2. Where are you from originally?

I grew up in International Falls, Minnesota. I later married and made a life in Oswego, IL which is a suburb of Chicago. We moved from there to The Villages.

3. Before you became a Villager, what kind of work were you involved in?

I was in charge of Abuse and Neglect Social Agencies under the Department of Children and Family Services. We served over eight counties surrounding Cook County. My career in the social service field lasted 31 years. My work also coordinated efforts with law enforcement agencies. We were able to start 5 different child advocacy centers through this join alliance while I was working in the Department of Children and Family Services.

4. What sort of work do you do now?

I've been retired since 2002, but stay active with Parrot Heads, golf and other volunteer activities.

5. What kind of volunteer work are you involved in as a member of The Parrot Heads?

I'm helping Mike Peacock as the Co-Chair with 5 o'clock Somewhere since last Spring. I'm also working on some other Parrot Head projects. In addition, I serve as Chair for the Christian Food Pantry in Lady Lake. Before that my wife and I were active members of The Optimist Club which I ended up leading for a couple years while we were in Illinois.

6. What are your 2 favorite things about The Villages?

Golf and The Parrot Heads.

7. Please name 2 of your favorite things about The Parrot Heads.

I like everything about the group. The Party with a Purpose is a great slogan and call to action. Thank you Jerry for your time today.
