There are now about 600 volunteers who provide the equivalent of \$1.2M-\$2.4M worth of service per year and there are many openings at the present time. With the expansion project now underway, which will add 100 rooms and enlarge the Emergency Department, there will be a need for 150 additional volunteers to provide the current level of service. This is a great way to "give back" to the community.


