HOSPITAL VOLUNTEER POINTS

The EXCOMM has approved the awarding of points to those members who volunteer at OUR hospital. If you have not already signed up to volunteer, you may contact Carol Hughes (carhughes@cfhalliance.org) to learn how to become a volunteer in one of the 25 departments at the hospital. There are now about 600 volunteers who provide the equivalent of \$1.2M-\$2.4M worth of service per year and there are many openings at the present time. With the expansion project now underway, which will add 100 rooms and enlarge the Emergency Department, there will be a need for 150 additional volunteers to provide the current level of service. This is a great way to "give back" to the community.

Volunteers already working should notify the Auxiliary office that they are Parrot Heads

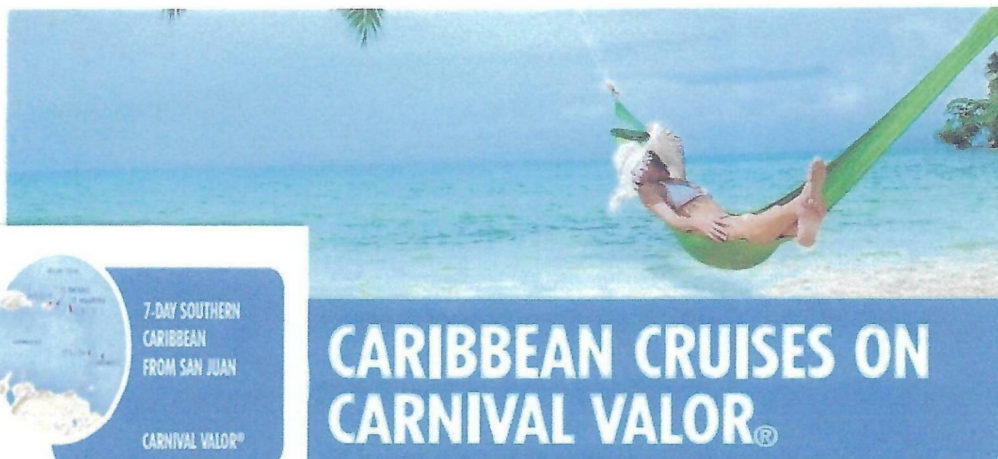
The Auxiliary will generate a monthly report

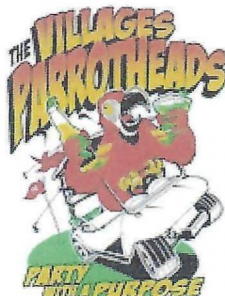
