A statement from Steve Larson, Community Relations Trustee

There seems to be some confusion about the fundraisers hosted by Cody's and I would like to give everyone an overview of these events. The Executive Committee, based on a recommendation of the Charity Committee, selects the individual charities and the number of fundraisers to be held. Volunteers sell the wristbands, 50/50 tickets and raffle tickets and we keep all of the funds collected. We solicit advertising merchandise to be raffled from local distributors who support our fundraisers. Cody's provides the food and their outside bar area at no charge to the Club. In the most recent fundraiser we generated \$1245 which was given to Veterans Helping Veterans at the end of the event.

The benefits Cody's receives is the Club goodwill and the knowledge that they are helping a local charity. They are the only restaurant that we have found that has the space to accommodate our event and is willing to give us free food to make the fundraiser a success.


