

#### INTERVIEW WITH RENIE LARSON

Chair of "Help US Help Kids & Teachers"



Renie and her husband Steve have lived in the Village of Buttonwood since 2011. They began their life in The Villages in 2005 when they both still worked and came here part-time. In 2010 they retired and lived in Liberty Park until their house in Buttonwood was built.

They joined the Parrot Heads in 2010 when they lived here full time. A bunch of their friends told them about the club so they attended one of the Phlockings with them and decided to join the club.

Renie tried a lot of activities when they first moved here including Tai Chi, water aerobics and Mah-Jongg. Mah-Jongg won her heart and she continues with that today along with the Parrot Head club. As they became more involved with the Parrot Heads they decided to focus all of their energies there and that is what most of their social activities are based on.

Renie was born and raised in Wichita, Kansas. In 1973 they moved to Pinckney, Michigan where they remained for 37 years and raised their family.

After teaching elementary school for two years, Renie became a stay-at-home Mom until their youngest child was five at which time she was able to go back to work as a substitute elementary school teacher. She feels she was very fortunate to be hired on full-time as a teacher when she was 48 years old. She loved teaching and third grade was her passion!

Renie has volunteered for the Parrot Head Halloween Party as assistant chair-person for two years and as chair-person for two more years. For the last three years she has been involved in Operation Backpack, now called Help Us Help Kids and Teachers, the name that she and her co-chair Marsha Herring decided on. Local schools are interviewed and then a recommendation is made to EXCOM as to which school they would like to sponsor depending upon their needs.

This year they would like to sponsor the Wildwood Middle High School because kids that are needy in elementary school are still needy when they move up to middle school and high school. There is currently a lot of support for local elementary schools supplied by church groups and other Village clubs. The middle-schools and high schools have needs that are not being met. Besides the usual pens and papers, they need post-it notes, graph paper, accessories for the laptops they use in class, as well as help to enhance their technology.

The things that Renie most enjoys about the Parrot Heads are the social aspect of the club where you can meet so many people and of course the charitable work that the club is involved in. She would advise new members that the easiest way to meet new people is to volunteer to work on committees, attend as many social events as they can, and participate in some of the "cliques" which are smaller groups where it is easier to meet people.
