






The Villages Parrot Heads Club would like to thank all who took the time to help others by donating blood in 2024. 6 blood drives were held throughout the year and 2419 pints of blood were collected. This equates to just over 302 gallons of blood. Or to put it more into perspective, if you had an oil tank in your basement, for heat, we filled it with blood.

This is the first time that any organization has exceeded 2000 pints of blood in one year and we have exceeded our goal which is an annual goal to match the year, 2024, with pints of blood and we are excited that we matched and surpassed that goal. The Villages Parrot heads club remains the largest blood donation organization in the state of Florida

Special thank you to Skip Todd, our blood drive chairperson, who we respectfully call our "Head Vampire" as he always tries to get blood from people. And special thanks to Franny Durr who is our volunteer coordinator for the blood drives. We would also like to thank our club members who donated 1,499 hours towards our mission. And again – thank you to all who took the time to donate to this worthwhile cause

As you may or may not know, one pint of blood can help save the lives of up to three people, so because of everyone, we helped save the lives of up to 7,257 people. And most, if not all, of the blood donated will stay in the Florida area



HOW DO YOU EARN "VOLUNTEER PARROT POINTS"?

(created 7/22/24)

Earning Parrot Points

Some of you might ask, What are volunteer Parrot Points and what are they used for? Members can earn Parrot Points from volunteering at our club's various events. For example: taking attendance at Phlockings, selling 50/50 tickets, donating blood, volunteering at the blood drive, helping at parties, and/or volunteering at any of our 3 big events per year (chili cook off, poker run, golf tournament).

Accumulating Parrot Points

Points are accumulated on a "rolling" 12 month period, i.e., from February to January or July to June. The rolling system works when points for a new month are posted and the points for the prior year period are dropped. For example: July points for the current year are posted, the July points for the previous year will drop off. The only way your accumulated Parrot Point totals will change is when a new month is tallied and posted.

Posting Monthly Parrot Points

The total of all Members' Parrot Points are posted each month on our website: villagesparrotheads.com, Quick Links, Check Earned Points. Monthly, event chairs submit the earned Parrot Points to me to track, tally, and post for the member's review. Check your points each month and let me know if you think any Parrot Points are missing.

Thanking you, our Members

Parrot Points are given to those members rewarding the volunteer work they have done for our club. And this is one of the ways we thank you for volunteering. Parrot Points are then recognized to purchase advance ticket sales, advance priority event seating, receive an invitation to the annual Volunteer Appreciation event (specific yearly total must be accumulated), and to receive a Volunteer Appreciation Pin in recognition for your Volunteer efforts. And, you do not lose Parrot Points if you use them to purchase advance ticket sales or priority seating.



Dear Fellow Cruisers,

This is Steve & Mitzi Daggett, your bus coordinators for our upcoming cruise aboard the NCL EPIC in February 2025

You are receiving this email because you have indicated you are wanting to take the bus to PORT CANAVERAL.

We have finalized our bus count and list based on your responses and the number of occupants; we have cancelled one bus but still have three (3) busses reserved from Lamers Transportation. Thank you for your responses and now it's time to secure them with payment.

The following is some important information for you: Please print and keep the email for safe keeping and future reference

Feb 15 -- Bus, PICK UP AND ASSIGNMENT FOR DEPARTURE to PORT CANAVERAL:

- 1. Busses will leave for Port Canaveral from the WALMART store located on 466. Busses will be near the garden center.
- 2. Busses will leave promptly at 9:30 on Feb.15 and return to same location.
- 3. You will be assigned a bus number and boarding order per bus once all payments are received.
- 4. Busses will be numbered 1-2-3. this will also be your bus for your return home on Feb
- 5. Should you wish to be boarded with friends please indicate who is in your travel party when you make your payment.
- 6. Snacks and beverages are allowed on the bus in a secure container (with lids). No glass is allowed

1. Parking is strictly at your own risk should you leave your car in the Walmart parking lot. It is highly suggested you find a friend, neighbor, taxi or uber for drop off and pick up.

- 1.All luggage you will NOT need until you are actually on board the ship will be stored in the undercarriage of the bus compartment, and you will not have access to it again until you are in your stateroom.
- 2. Your carryon goes on the bus with you, and you will carry it off.
