

As was noted in July's Webmaster News, an abundance of our Club's past newsletters has been added to the website going back to the club's founding in 2004. Many of the newsletters scanned were pictures rather than text. To convert the documents to text, I ran 112 of 198 newsletters through Optical Character Recognition (OCR) software so membership can search on a friend's name, a particular event, etc. on the newsletters. In the spirit of building an online history, I also added Excomm (Coco-Nutz) minutes from 2020, 2019, and a smattering of earlier years. It's all an interesting read, and feedback from membership is they really enjoy going back through the years.

New this month is a Digital Safety bulletin posted on our <u>Help Desk website</u>. This document discusses some of the vulnerabilities when on the internet, and measures you can take to help protect yourself. There's a whole lot of information there, perhaps some aspects you were not aware of. It was developed with the membership in mind, keeping them safe while on the web and our website!

The staff and volunteers at Shepherd's Lighthouse are committed to helping families navigate through life's challenges and learn how to face challenges with confidence in a safe atmosphere of faith, family, and friends. Along with a successful transitional living program, they also manage affordable apartment living, to help people by rescuing, empowering, and renewing their lives. They are a non-profit charity that is funded by various groups that allow them to help with the needs of families which, on average, total about 200 clients at a time.

Shepard's Lighthouse is honored to be part of St. Theresa's commendable efforts which includes a soup kitchen, food pantry. thrift store and more.

Shepherd's Lighthouse has 11 Board Members, 4 Staff Members, and over 25 Volunteer; and no one is paid.

Next year in February 2026, a 25th Anniversary fundraiser is planned with dinner, speakers and more. It is open to the pblic.

In addition to cash donations, Shepherd's Lighthouse is preparing for the hurricane season and they need batteries, water, paper plates, paper towels, and normal hurricane needs.

Earning Parrot Points

Some of you might ask, What are volunteer Parrot Points and what are they used for? Members can earn Parrot Points from volunteering at our club's various events. For example: taking attendance at Phlockings, selling 50/50 tickets, donating blood, volunteering at the blood drive, helping at parties, and/or volunteering at any of our 3 big events per year (chili cook off, poker run, golf tournament).

Accumulating Parrot Points

Points are accumulated on a "rolling" 12 month period, i.e., from February to January or July to June. The rolling system works when points for a new month are posted and the points for the prior year period are dropped. For example: July points for the current year are posted, the July points for the previous year will drop off. The only way your accumulated Parrot Point totals will change is when a new month is tallied and posted.

Posting Monthly Parrot Points

The total of all Members' Parrot Points are posted each month on our website:

https://villagesparrotheads.com, Quick Links, Check Earned Points. Monthly, event chairs submit the earned Parrot Points to me to track, tally, and post for the member's review. Check your points each month and let me know if you think any Parrot Points are missing.

Thanking you, our Members

Parrot Points are given to those members rewarding the volunteer work they have done for our club. And this is one of the ways we thank you for volunteering.

Parrot Points are then recognized to purchase advance ticket sales, advance priority event seating, receive an invitation to the annual Volunteer Appreciation event (specific yearly total must be accumulated), and to receive a Volunteer Appreciation Pin in recognition for your Volunteer efforts.

And, you do not lose Parrot Points if you use them to purchase advance ticket sales or priority seating.






