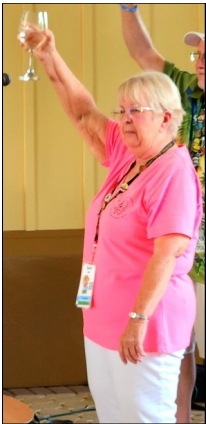
In May Phlockings will have some new music so come check them all out. We also anticipate a major announcement coming soon, so stay tuned and read your emails.

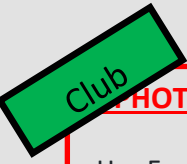
At the April 13<sup>th</sup> flocking, a check for \$1,000 was presented to Barb McManus, President of the Board of Directors of the Wildwood Soup Kitchen. During the month of April, a anonymous donor matched our contribution so the Soup Kitchen will receive \$2,000 – Thank You Donor. The Wildwood Soup Kitchen was started in 1992. In 2011, the Soup Kitchen remodeled to ensure the facility met current food safety standards. The Wildwood Soup Kitchen serves meals to the unfortunate, the homeless, the hungry, and the lonely by providing healthy, nutritious and tasty meals to all who request them. Almost all meals are full-course dinners, including a meat, vegetable, salad, bread, dessert, and drink. On Tue, Thu, & Sat (11:00am - 12:30pm), about 100 meals/day are prepared in-house and about 500 meals/day are prepared for take-out. Approximately 3,000 meals per week are delivered to those who are unable to come to the Soup Kitchen. The Wildwood Soup Kitchen is staffed by over 150 volunteers who are inspired to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, and welcome the stranger. Their staff is 100% volunteers and no one is paid. Once a year, the Seeds of Hope (SOH) volunteers arrange a food fund and awareness-raising committee for the Wildwood Soup Kitchen and the Wildwood Food Pantry. SOH arranges events, concerts, and food drives that take place each year during the 2 1/2-week period leading up to Easter. All food collected is shared between the Wildwood Soup Kitchen and the Food Pantry. And, at the end of this food drive, a pancake breakfast is held at the Soup Kitchen. Aside from money, the Wildwood Soup Kitchen needs Food Pantry donations that include any non-perishable items.

## **Earning Parrot Points**

Some of you might ask, What are volunteer Parrot Points and what are they used for? Members can earn Parrot Points from volunteering at our club's various events. For example: taking attendance at Phlockings, selling 50/50 tickets, donating blood, volunteering at the blood drive, helping at parties, and/or volunteering at any of our 3 big events per year (chili cook off, poker run, golf tournament).

## **Accumulating Parrot Points**

Points are accumulated on a "rolling" 12 month period, i.e., from February to January or July to June. The rolling system works when points for a new month are posted and the points for the prior year period are dropped. For example: July points for the current year are posted, the July points for the previous year will drop off. The only way your accumulated Parrot Point totals will change is when a new month is tallied and posted.

## **Posting Monthly Parrot Points**

The total of all Members' Parrot Points are posted each month on our website: villagesparrot-heads.com, Quick Links, Check Earned Points. Monthly, event chairs submit the earned Parrot Points to me to track, tally, and post for the member's review. Check your points each month and let me know if you think any Parrot Points are missing.

## **Thanking you, our Members**

Parrot Points are given to those members rewarding the volunteer work they have done for our club. And this is one of the ways we thank you for volunteering.

**Parrot Points are then recognized to purchase advance ticket sales, advance priority event seating, receive an invitation to the annual Volunteer Appreciation event (specific yearly total must be accumulated), and to receive a Volunteer Appreciation Pin in recognition for your Volunteer efforts.**

And, you do not lose Parrot Points if you use them to purchase advance ticket sales or priority seating.
