Registration for each scramble is \$5.00, non-refundable.

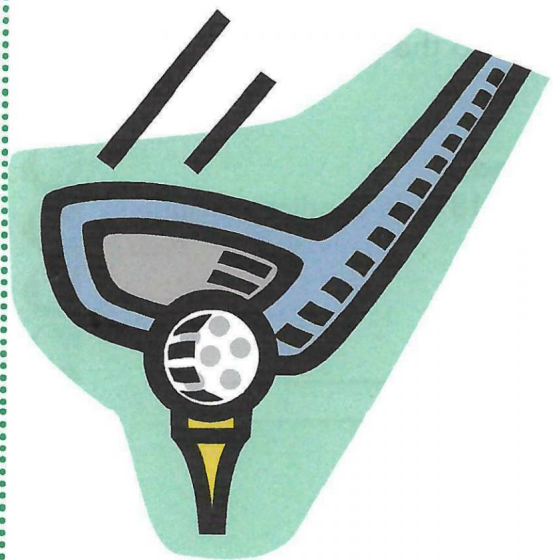
Sign up for TVPH Spring/Summer Executive Course Golf Scrambles will start in April. This year's scheduled scrambles will be on the following dates and courses:

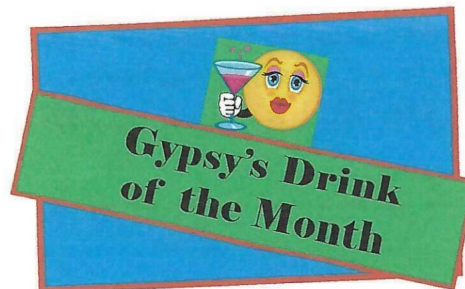

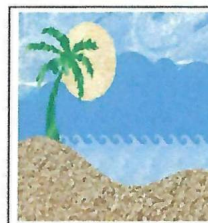
