Members of our Club will be invited to attend a "Meet and Greet" at the Waterfront Inn Friday, August 17th from 5:00-10:00PM.



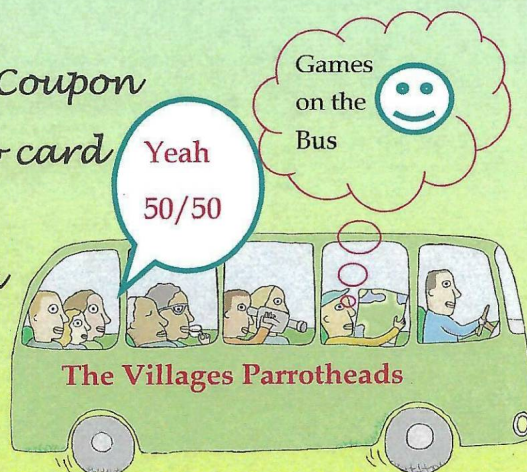
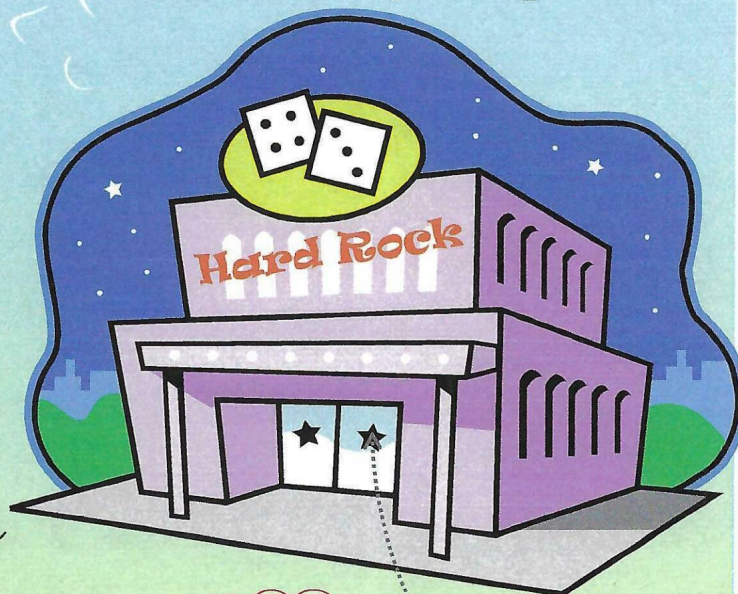
