https://www.jimmybuffett.com/ is the official website of Jimmy and has a lot of information including links to Margaritaville. TV and Radio Margaritaville. There are also opportunities for apparel shopping from past concerts. You can buy a vintage 1979 Cheeseburger in Paradise and/or look for that T-shirt you never bought.

https://www.margaritaville.com/ is the domain of the Margaritaville Holdings, Inc, of which Jimmy has a 28% stake. The enterprise, founded in 1998, has website links to the various Margaritaville resorts, restaurants and more. Interestingly, Chi-Chi's tried to trademark "Margaritaville" as a drink special. Buffett sued, won, and the terms Jimmy Buffett, Margaritaville, and Parrotheads are now registered trademarks of Margaritaville.

https://www.buffettnews.com/ was created in 1997 and is "the internet's largest Jimmy Buffett fansite". This fansite includes a discussion board, photo gallery and an archive of Jimmy Buffett concerts. Jimmy had a Nashville concert in 1971 when he was 25 years old, remember?

https://phlockersmagazine.com/ is a great site if you are looking for current news about TropRock events. It's a monthly online magazine for Parrot Head Clubs worldwide featuring musicians, songwriters, bands, charity events and trop rock music! Phlockers magazine has been in publication for 10 years with its debut issue being September 2014.

Lastly, https://phip.com/ is the website for Parrot Head Clubs in Paradise (PHIP), established in 1994 as the "Official Jimmy Buffet Fan Club". The website has links to 210 chapters across North America, with The Villages Parrot Head Club being the largest chapter.
