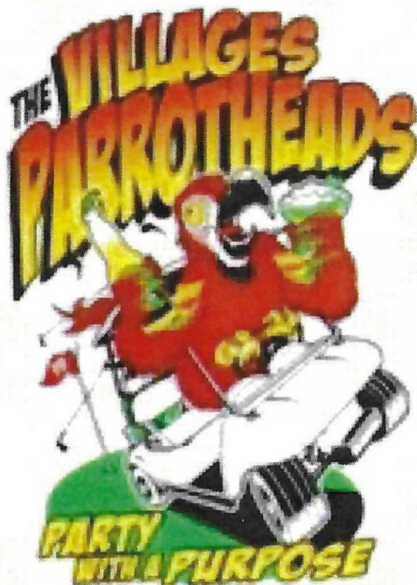

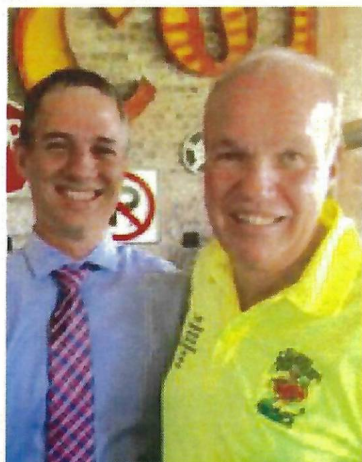
## CHARITY NEWS
