

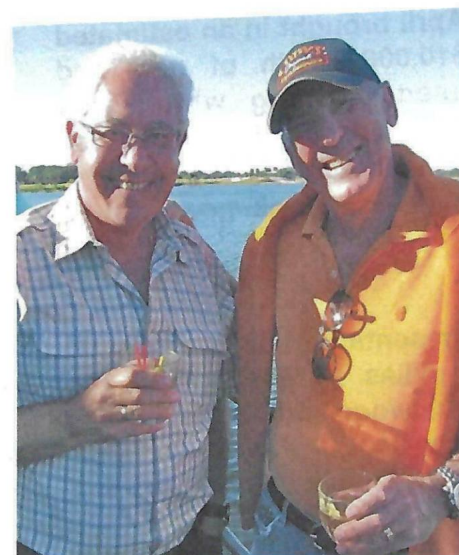

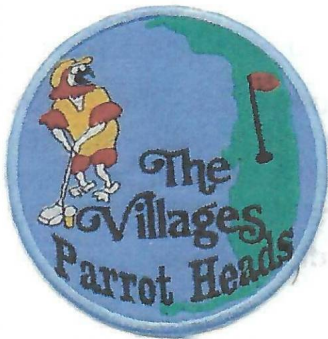

### Leadership conference

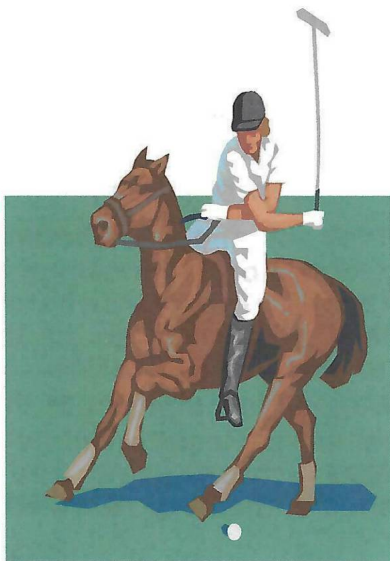
