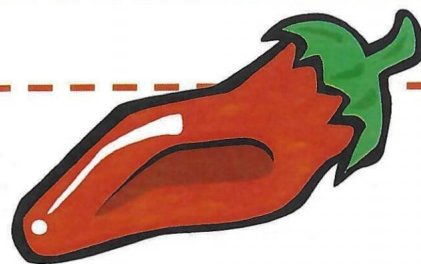

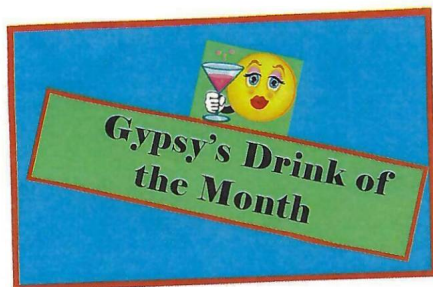

Sugar Plum - Pitcher Drink

If you use Goldschlager (which is colorless), this drink will be a shimmering golden color; using red cinnamon schnapps turns it pink.

Makes 12 6-ounce servings

1 750 ml bottle (25.4 ounces) spiced rum
 2 cups (16 ounces) Calvados or other apple brandy
 1 1/2 cups (12 ounces) Tuaca
 1 1/2 cups (12 ounces) Galliano
 3/4 cup (6 ounces) Goldschlager or other cinnamon schnapps

Garnish: 36 brightly colored gumdrops

Combine all ingredients in a pitcher that holds at least 80 ounces; stir well. Can be served immediately or covered and refrigerated until ready to serve. Fill 10-ounce wineglasses almost full with crushed ice; add six ounces of drink mixture. Garnish each drink with 3 gumdrops speared on a cocktail pick; serve with a straw.

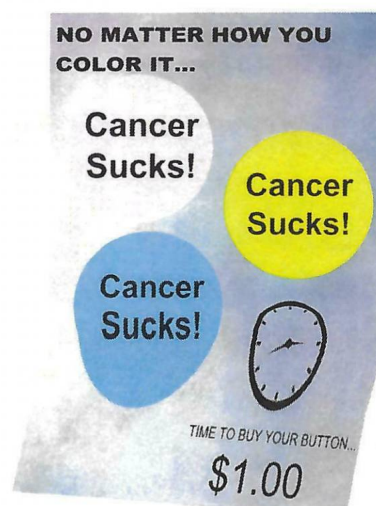
