# Food from Judy's Kitchen

## Margarita Sorbet

2 limes, one cut in half and squeezed, one cut in six thin rings

Margarita salt

- 1 six-ounce container of frozen limeade concentrate
- 1 six-ounce container frozen pineapple concentrate
  - 2 cups Tequila Gold
  - 1 cup triple sec
  - 4 trays of ice cubes

Best if made and served immediately. Makes 12 cocktails

# Spicey Guacamole

- 1 large ripe avocado, peeled and pitted
- 2 teaspoons fresh lime juice one-half cup chopped fresh cilantro one-quarter cup finely chopped onion

- 2 large garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 2 large serrano chilies, seeded and chopped one-quarter teaspoon salt

Using fork, mash avocado with lime juice in small bowl. Add cilantro, chopped onion, chopped garlic, serrano chilies and salt. Stir to combine.
